OVERVIEW

Dallion Johnson is a skilled guard best known for his perimeter shooting and smooth mid-range game. A former standout at Florida Gulf Coast University, Johnson has developed into a confident scorer who can create his own shot or space the floor as an off-ball threat. He is very comfortable pulling up off the dribble, particularly from three and mid-range, and plays with patience under pressure.

He is a disciplined player who understands spacing, makes sound reads, and rarely forces low-percentage looks. With his balanced offensive skill set, Johnson projects as a reliable perimeter scorer in competitive European leagues.

STRENGTHS

- Elite Perimeter Shooting: Smooth mechanics with deep range; quick release allows him to get shots off against closeouts.
- Mid-Range Pull-Up: Very comfortable stopping on a dime to rise into jumpers off the dribble.
- Composure Under Pressure: Stays calm when run off the line, makes intelligent shot selections.
- Off-Ball IQ: Understands how to relocate, cut, and position himself to maximize spacing.
- Work Ethic & Discipline: Reputation as a coachable, hard-working player who thrives in structured systems.

WEAKNESSES

- Limited Rim Pressure: Relies more on shooting than attacking the basket; not a downhill slasher.
- Playmaking: More of a scorer than a creator—doesn't consistently collapse defenses to set up teammates.
- Athletic Ceiling: Solid but not explosive; may struggle defensively against elite Euro guards with burst.

PLAYING STYLE & PROJECTION

Johnson is a sharpshooting guard who thrives in structured offenses that prioritize spacing and ball movement. He projects as a specialist who can swing momentum with his outside shooting while also providing mid-range balance. Defensively, he will need to adapt to faster European guards, but his discipline and awareness give him a chance to hold his own.

With continued confidence and consistency from deep, Johnson can grow into a starting-caliber 2-guard in mid-level European leagues and potentially attract attention from higher levels if his scoring efficiency holds.



COMPARABLE PLAYERS

Billy Baron (Reyer Venezia, Italy / EuroCup)

Dallion Johnson's game shares many qualities with Billy Baron, one of Europe's most respected perimeter shooters. Both are guards who thrive on movement, using screens and relocation to free themselves for clean looks. Johnson, like Baron, brings poise under pressure and the ability to swing momentum with consistent outside scoring. While Baron contributes more as a secondary playmaker, Johnson mirrors his role as a reliable, disciplined shot-maker who fits seamlessly into structured European systems



Marcus Eriksson (Gran Canaria, ACB / EuroCup)

Johnson's style is reminiscent of Marcus Eriksson, a polished European shooter known for his quick release and balance from deep. Like Eriksson, Johnson excels at spacing the floor, running off screens, and staying dangerous off the ball. Both are smooth and efficient, forcing defenses to track them constantly. Though Eriksson adds more size and ACB-level experience, Johnson projects a similar profile as a disciplined scoring guard whose value comes from consistency, movement, and knockdown perimeter shooting.



CONCLUSION

Dallion Johnson is a confident shooter and disciplined guard with a clear identity: spacing the floor, hitting shots, and playing within the system. His ability to shoot off the dribble and off the catch makes him a valuable piece for European teams needing reliable perimeter scoring. With time and experience, he can become a consistent impact player in Sweden and beyond.
